This is only the expected schedule. Rounds will start early if it finishes early. At least 10 minutes gap will be there between rounds. Top players from these selections will be selected for the final phase of selections. (Top 8 from the men's category and top 9 from the women's category will be selected to have a final squad of 14 players each)

Fair play measures

- The event will be held according to the latest FIDE online regulations.
- Zoom will be used as the conference platform.
- Only laptops and personal computers are allowed (mobile phones, tablet computers are not allowed)
- It is every player's individual responsibility to have a working camera and a working microphone during playing sessions. External webcams are allowed.
- Players are required to be on a video call via Zoom and remain visible in their cameras during their games (you can turn it off after your game ends). The room lighting should be sufficient to allow broadcasting and movement of a player's eyes. Players are required to move their camera to show the arbiters their playing area upon request. The entire Zoom monitoring sessions, including video and audio, shall be recorded.
- Players shall not use virtual background.
- Players are required to share their screen (with Taskbar visible) and task manager when the play in progress with the Zoom call.

- Players are required to follow arbiters' instructions on keeping their microphones on or off. Arbiters may turn a player's microphone on or off for the purpose of ensuring fair play.
- No other software shall be running besides: a) Operating System, b) Antivirus, c) Zoom, d) Web browser that is connecting to Lichess, e) Software needed to make the camera work, f) Software needed to make the microphone work g) Task Manager.
- Headphones, earphones and any kind of audio device or electronic devices are not allowed during the rounds.
- Hats, caps, hoodies and any other unnecessary items covering the head are not allowed.
- Outside assistance of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- No spectators shall be allowed in the playing area.
- Players violating the requirements of above Articles may receive a warning or be forfeited for the current game by an arbiter.
- Players can report their opponent in case of suspected cheating after the game ends.
- All games are sent to the technical experts for fair play checks. If anyone found guilty, he will be removed from the event and whole points he scored will be removed. The opponents will be given the forfeit points for those games. The UOC will ban the player for 2 years
- Decision of the arbiters is final.
