

CHESS

1. Date, Time & Venue

Date: 7th of September 2024

Time: 8.30 am onwards

Venue: Indoor Stadium, University of Colombo

2. Registrations

Each faculty team should fill out the entry form and submit it to the Department of Physical Education on or before 12 noon, 4th of September 2024.

3. Rules & Regulations

- 3.1 The Championship will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the International Chess Federation, Sri Lanka Chess Federation, and tournament Rules laid down by the Department of Physical Education of the University of Colombo.
- 3.2 The following team championship will be conducted
 - Team Championship – Men
 - Team Championship – Women
- 3.3 The competition will be held on a knockout basis
- 3.4 Each faculty will be allowed to present 1 team from each category men and women
- 3.5 A team should comprise a maximum of eight members, including 2 drop (reserve) players and a minimum of six players.
- 3.6 Entry forms of the teams can be updated until the 1st round starts. The players will be registered in a board order in which they should play the whole tournament. For each round, 2 players will be dropped, and the remaining six players will play the round according to the board order.
- 3.7 The time control will be 10+5 minutes each. (10 minutes for each player and 5 seconds will be added per move)
- 3.8 Making an illegal move will result in the addition of one minute to the opponent's time while the second illegal move loses the game.

- 3.9 The team that wins 3.5 or more points out of six games will win the match. In any case, where the match ends with 3-3 for each team, a replay will be played between the two teams at a time control of 3+2. In any case, if that match is also drawn a game between 2 players nominated by the respective captains will be conducted under Armageddon rules and the result will be considered.
- 3.10 The colours of the teams for each match will be decided by a toss before starting the match.
- 3.11 Any team that is not present at the table 10 minutes from the start of the round will be considered to have given a walkover to their opponents.
- 3.12 The arbiter's decision will be the final decision.
